So, you want to be a Volunteer at Awanita Valley?

Great! We are excited that you are interested in serving Christ through Christian camping! Awanita is a great place to spend some summer sessions as well as some fall and winter weekends. There are some things you may want to know about Awanita Valley. We are a nondenominational Christian retreat center. Our goal is to serve all campers through our witness in any area of the camp.

Here are a few guidelines to help you in your decision to serve at Awanita. You must be at least 14 years old. A willingness to work at all assigned tasks to completion is essential. NO SMOKING, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR ILLEGAL DRUGS are allowed under any circumstances. Only Christian music is to be played in the Staff House. Please also remember that all attitudes are contagious, whether good or bad, and a positive attitude goes a long way! A handbook with more information will be provided to all volunteers upon their arrival at camp.

Your lodging will be provided in the Staff House while you are volunteering under the direct supervision of the Staff Parents. There is no charge for any meals, lodging, or recreation while you are serving as a volunteer. We do work diligently at Awanita, but that's not all we do! You will find yourself studying your Bible more, riding the Hummer at night, having a bonfire at the top of Hummer Hill, swimming in the lake, hiking, playing volleyball or basketball, going down the zip-line or slide, playing games or just taking it easy playing pool in the Staff House. Having fun after work is a top priority!

WHAT TO BRING AND WHAT NOT TO BRING

What to Bring:

- Your willingness to serve wherever needed, a great attitude, and a desire to dive into God's Word!
- Bible, notebook, pen
- Pillow and Twin size sheets/blanket or sleeping bag
- Toiletries (shampoo/soap, toothbrush/toothpaste, deodorant, hygiene products, etc.)
- Towel & washcloth
- Clothes (see dress code guidelines below) Don't bring too many! Storage space is limited.
- Modest swimsuit & beach towel
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Work shoes and tennis shoes. You *must* wear closed-toe shoes in the kitchen & on horses.
- Necessary medications (please tell your staff parents what you are taking)
- Drinks & snacks (must be labeled with your name unless you intend to share)

All items should be labeled with your name. Only Christian music is allowed.

Dress Code:

All clothing should be modest, with no offensive logos or designs. Shirts must cover your stomach and chest. No spaghetti straps. No short-shorts. Pants must cover your underwear. Long pants and closed-toe shoes or boots are required for grounds work and horse wranglers. Everyone must wear closed-toe shoes in the kitchen.

Swimwear: Girls' swimsuits should be one-piece or a tankini that covers your stomach and your entire bottom. Guys' should wear swim trunks, not speedo-style swimwear.

What Not to Bring:

- Bad attitudes, gossip, or laziness
- Large knives (pocket knives with blades less than 3 inches are allowed)
- Guns BB guns, 22s, etc.
- Fireworks, lighters, matches
- Cigarettes, alcohol, chewing tobacco, or illegal drugs
- Clothing that violates the dress code
- Ungodly books, novels, magazines, posters, etc.
- DVDs, movies, video games, or secular music
